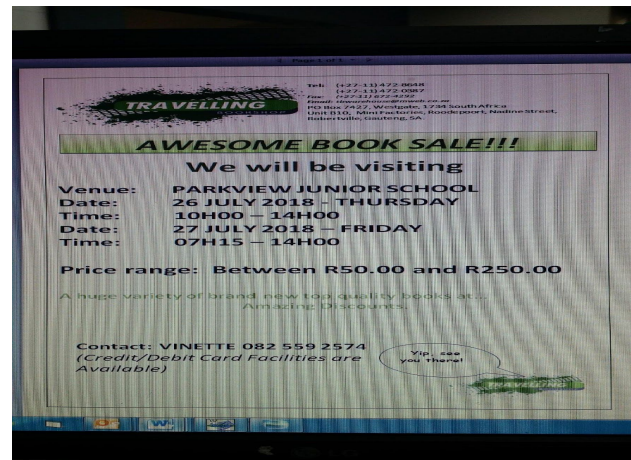
- GRADE 1-3 MUST REMAIN WITH THEIR HOUSES.
