WINTER UNIFORM

Children should be wearing full winter uniform now. Please note that you cannot mix the various sets.

Grade 1-3 winter sets are as follows:

SET 1

- Long grey trousers
- White long-sleeved button up shirt
- PVJ jersey
- OPTIONAL should you wish for your child to wear a jacket over their above uniform they may wear a PLAIN NAVY windbreaker/jacket (no other colours and no patterns)
- Black school shoes and grey socks

SET 2

- Navy blue PVJ school tunic
- White long-sleeved button up shirt
- PVJ jersey
- OPTIONAL should you wish for your child to wear a jacket over their above uniform they may wear a PLAIN NAVY windbreaker/jacket (no other colours and no patterns)
- Black school shoes
- Black or navy stockings or long black socks

SET 3 – this set can be worn at any point but must be worn on PE days

- PVJ navy tracksuit
- PVJ navy sports t-shirt to be worn under the tracksuit.
- PVJ jersey
- White takkies & white socks
- OPTIONAL a PLAIN white or navy long sleeve t-shirt may be worn under the sports shirt

Grade R winter uniform -

- Navy Gr R tracksuit
- Golf shirt
- OPTIONAL a PLAIN white or navy long sleeve t-shirt may be worn under the Golf shirt
- PVJ jersey under the tracksuit
- OPTIONAL should you wish for your child to wear a jacket over their above uniform they may wear a PLAIN NAVY windbreaker/jacket (no other colours and no patterns)
