FUN DAYS IN DECEMBER

Please note that <u>Monday, 6 December</u> is the last official day on which all learners are expected to attend school.

Our Fun Days are from Tuesday 7 – Friday 10 December. On these days learners will need to be collected at 12:30 from the Selkirk Gate. Aftercare will be available for those who need it at a charge of R60. Please notify your class teacher should you require aftercare. Booking is essential.

An official invitation will be sent out to accommodate 1 parent per child for the final assembly.

Please arrive from 7:15 onwards to allow for all COVID Protocols to be observed. The rule of No Mask=No entry will apply. The hall doors will be closed at 7:50 and no late arrivals will be allowed into the hall.

On <u>Tuesday</u>, 7 <u>December</u> ONLY **Grade 3** learners are expected to attend school for their final assembly and fun day.

On <u>Wednesday, 8 December</u> ONLY **Grade 2** learners will be expected to attend school for their final assembly and fun day.

On <u>Thursday, 9 December</u> ONLY **Grade 1** learners will be expected to attend school for their final assembly and fun day.

On <u>Friday, 10 December</u> ONLY **Grade R** learners will be expected to attend school for their final assembly and fun day.

SIGNS OF POSITIVITY

Often schools don't have the budget for these very necessary 'nice-to-haves', so Whack Art and Design asks businesses and organisations with appropriate brands to sponsor Signs of Positivity in schools in exchange for the opportunity of some brand exposure and a direct association with positive vibes. Whack Art and Design generates income and provides job opportunities through design, production, project management and installation of the signs. The standard set of signs includes 10 large outdoor signs and 90 smaller indoor signs, with a sponsor acknowledgement plaque in each classroom and under each of the outdoor signs.

The school, the children, the teachers, the community, the sponsor, SMME'S and Whack Art and Design benefit from this partnership. It's a win-win situation - but it's not just big brands that can spread positive vibes...
