### PRINCIPAL'S DESK

### LEARNER ATTENDANCE

All learners are expected to attend school until Thursday 2 December.

On Monday 6 December – all learners are expected at school for our assembly. Dismissal will be at 12:30. Please collect from your usual grade collection gate.

Parents are requested to make arrangements with their transport to collect children on time during the following weeks.
